**EX PARTE ORDER**

UPON THE EX PARTE APPLICATION of the Applicant; AND UPON reading the Affidavit of Alan Wood and having reference to the Expert's Report of Lisa Majeau Gordon; AND UPON hearing submissions of counsel for the Applicant; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Applicant shall follow the following process in advance of its application for advice and direction including approval of payment of expenses and a proposed distribution of the Applicant's assets, scheduled for December 19, 2016:
  - a. the Applicant shall serve on each Respondent by registered mail and email, where available, the following documents on or before September 1, 2016:

- i. the Originating Notice herein filed August 5, 2016;
  - ii. this Ex Parte Order; and
  - iii. a letter setting out:
    1. an internet address from which copies of the Affidavit of Alan Wood and Expert's Report of Lisa Majeau Gordon may be downloaded;
    2. a statement of the payment which that Respondent would receive if the distribution sought by the Applicant were approved, if any, assuming the total assets available for distribution will be \$13,500,000; and
    3. the date, time, and means of accessing by internet the webinar described below;
- b. the Applicant may apply ex parte to vary the form of service and length of notice based on particular circumstances of one or more Respondents;
  - c. the Applicant shall maintain a website from which copies of the Affidavit of Alan Wood and Expert's Report of Lisa Majeau Gordon may be downloaded, from August 16, 2016 until issuance of a decision on the Application herein, presently scheduled for hearing on December 19, 2016;
  - d. the Applicant shall conduct at least one webinar accessible by internet access between September 7, 2016 and October 21, 2016 at which Alan Wood and Lisa Majeau Gordon will be available to respond to questions from the Respondents;
  - e. any Respondent opposing or seeking a variation of the proposed payment of expenses and distribution of assets set out in the proposed order which is Schedule "B" to the Originating Application, shall notify the Applicant's counsel, Grant Dunlop, by email or fax on or before October 31, 2016.
2. Any Respondent may apply for a variation of this Ex Parte Order on five days' notice to the Applicant. Notice to the other Respondents is not initially required, but may be directed on the hearing of any such variation application.
